AS SOME OF YOU KNOW BACK IN OCT 31,2008 I GOT A 1949 CHEVORLET FLEET LINE 4 DOOR. I HAD TO DO A LITTLE TENDER LOVE AND CARE ON THE 49; IT WAS CONVERTED TO A 12-VOLT SYSTEM, NEW ALTERNATOR, COIL, I ELIMINATED THE POINT SYSTEM, AND INSTALLED AN ELECTRONIC IGNITION. CHANGED ALL THE OUTSIDE LIGHT BULBS AND UNDER THE DASH BULBS TO 12 VOLTS BULBS. DRIVER SIDE WINDOW WAS CRACKED, PUT IN NEW WINDOW. CHANGED OUT RIGHT SIDE DOOR LOCK. ADDED TWO FRONT HORNS, CHANGED SPARK PLUGS, OIL, PAN GASKET.WHEN CURTIS TOOK THE FRONT RIGHT WHEEL OFF, YOU WOULD NOT BELEAVE WHAT WE SAW. A WIRE WITH 3 TO 4 NUTS WRAPED AROUND THE DRUM. 
