TREASUERS REPORT: Checking, Savings, Special Saving and Edward Jones accounts reviewed. Group discussed need to have monthly treasurer reports as we have very little change in saving accounts. MOTION by Adeline and seconded by Shirley that Treasurer will continue to develop monthly reports but to report to the club on a quarterly basis. Motion Carried. Next Treasurer's report will be at the April meeting. Teresa reported that checks have been sent to the Infant Crisis Center and the Boys Ranch.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS:

- **Dues:** Dues are now due—\$20/ year. Dues will be collected at the February and March meetings. Dues are delinquent after March 31.
- Presentation was given about the AMBUCS trike program by Monty Courtney. The trike is specially built, based on physical, occupational and medical reports, to provide maximum mobility for the individual, Its takes about 9-12 months to build and a child trike is about \$800 and an adult one averages \$1,100. Individuals to be eligible must not be able to pay for the trike cost. When our trike is finished, we will be notified and at that time club can plan for the presentation. AMBUCS also builds home ramps for disabled individuals. The final donation, following meeting, will be submitted to AMBUCS.
- **Next years** 2022 cruise will be managed by Arkansas, Randy and Dolly Resh will host at Days Inn (Best Western) in Poteau, Oct 28-30, 2022.
- 2023 will be our Club's turn for the fall foliage cruise. Club discussed potential
 sites such as Lake Murray, Bartlesville, Pittsburg, KS and Hot Springs, AR. Members who would like to visit potential sites can report back to Dale and the committee. Committee will be formed so start thinking about locations and cruise
 routes. Any ideas for event, notify Dale.
- <u>SHOWS AND EVENTS</u> No report but Dale commented that the Tri5 is in May at Pigeon Forge, Tenn.
- No further news about the potential Nomad Show in OK.
