I can buy anything I want.Lucky man

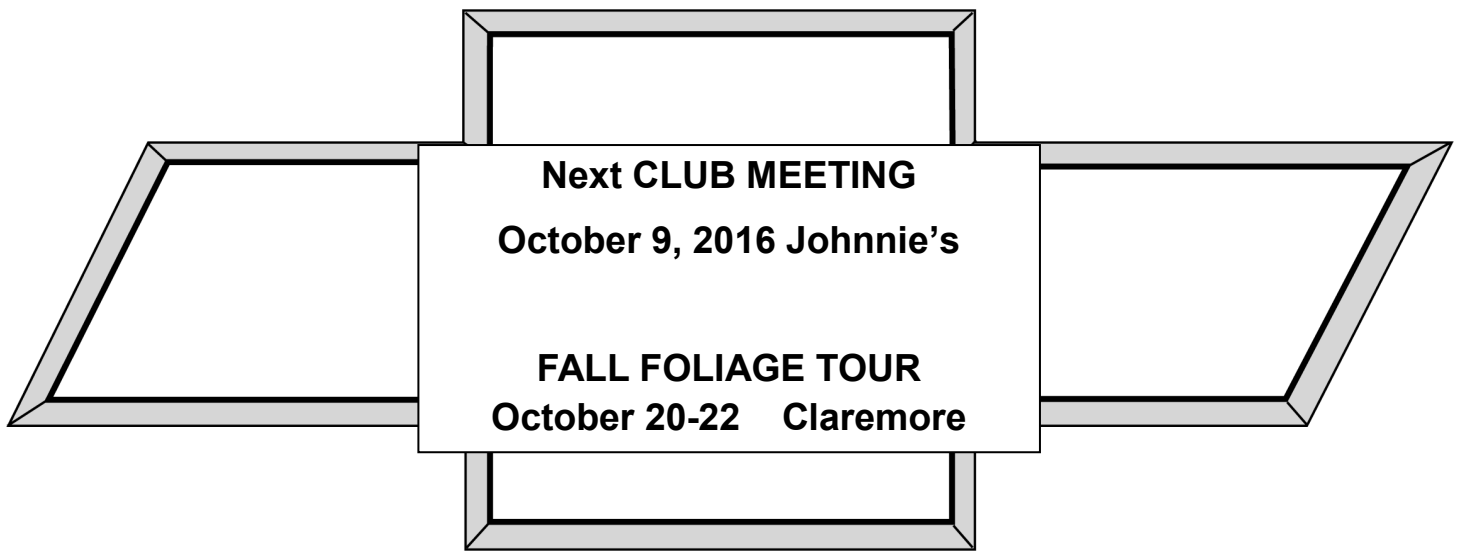
